The Most Holy Trinity - Intimacy and Trinity

"The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all!" —2 Corinthians 13:13

When we awoke this morning, many of us began the day in a most appropriate way by making the sign of the cross and proclaiming: "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." When we went to Mass, we began "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Then the Mass, the day, and our lives continued with multiple references to the Trinity. We are a Trinitarian people. We are baptized in, immersed in the Trinity (Mt 28:19). We are so preoccupied with the Trinity because we love God, and God has revealed to us that He is Trinity. When we love someone, we want to know and love him or her as he or she is. We would be broken-hearted if we could never love a spouse or a child as they are. This would prevent us from loving them deeply and intimately.

Because of our human limitations, of ourselves we cannot know God as He is and love Him deeply and intimately. However, the Lord has revealed Himself to us as Trinity. He has become incarnate, continued His incarnate presence in the Church, given Himself to us in Holy Communion, and made our bodies His dwelling place. Because the Trinity has revealed Himself to us in His awesome plan of salvation, we can love God deeply as He is. This intimacy is the reason we have been created.

The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus: The Two Elements of Devotion to the Sacred Heart: Consecration and Reparation: We consecrate ourselves to the Sacred Heart by acknowledging Him as Creator and Redeemer and as having full rights over us as King of Kings, by repenting, and by resolving to serve Him. We make reparation for the indifference and ingratitude with which He is treated and for leaving Him abandoned by humanity. He promised that, in response to those who consecrate themselves and make reparations to His Sacred Heart: He will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life. He will establish peace in their homes. He will comfort them in all their afflictions. He will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death. He will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings. Sinners will find in His Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy. Lukewarm souls shall become fervent. Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection. He will bless every place in which an image of His Heart is exposed and honored. He will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts. Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in His Heart. In the excessive mercy of His Heart, His all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in His disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. His divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment. The devotions attached to these promises are: Receiving Communion frequently First Fridays: going to Confession and receiving the Eucharist on the first Friday of each month for nine consecutive months. Many parishes will offer public First Friday devotions; if they do, you must perform First Fridays publicly. If it isn't so offered in your parish, you can do this privately, going to Confession, receiving the Eucharist, and offering your prayers for the intention of the Holy Father. Holy Hour: Eucharistic Adoration for one hour on Thursdays. ("Could you not watch one hour with me?") Holy Hour can be made alone or as part of a group with formal prayers. Celebrating of the Feast of the Sacred Heart.
